Pathfinder Uniform Recommendations

Pants



Black dress pants with belt loops such as Dockers. Uniformity: Should be maintained as much as possible within the Club No Spandex or Jeans

Skirts

Black "A" line design with belt loops. Uniformity: All female Pathfinders in a club need to be in pants or in skirts but not mixed

Belt & Buckle

Black web belt with Pathfinder buckle

Scarf/Neckerchief & Slide

Yellow Pathfinder neckerchief with black silk screened logo and worn over the collar and sash. The slide is worn right side up when viewed by another person.

Uniformity: Black Slide and Black silk screen neckerchief's only.

Shoes

Black polishable dress shoes or boots with fully closed toe. Heels of no more than 1 inch. No sneakers, slides, or heeled clogs. Shoe strings must be black.

Socks & Hosiery

Black Socks. Hosiery for female Pathfinders should be skin toned, or black, with no designs. Fishnet stockings are not allowed.

<u>Shirt/Blouse</u>

Khaki short or long sleeve shirts are at the clubs discretion and should be uniform throughout the club. Black long sleeve undergarments may be worn under the shirt for added comfort. "Left" and "Right" refers to the wearer's "Left" or "Right"

	Class Pins	Placed on the pocket flap next to each other in a line with minimal spacing. Friend Pin (or the lowest class earned) on the side of the flap near the shirt's center and in ascending order towards the left sleeve side of the flap.		
	Baptismal Pin	Placed on the same line as the class pins and $\frac{1}{2}$ inch from the left sleeve side of the pocket flap.		
	Class Strip Located directly Advanced Class Ribbons or Bars Good Conduct Ribbons or Bars Captain and Scribe Pins/Plates		y above and centered on the pocket.	
			Placed above the class strip, combination ribbon or bar holders are permitted	
			Placed above the class strip and/or above the Advanced Class Ribbons or Bars	
			Optional - Placed directly in the center of the pocket under the button (not on the pocket flap)	
	Drill Down Medals		Pinned directly to the pocket flap just above the bottom edge.

	Blue Conference Patch Pathfinder World Patch		1/4 inch below the shoulder seam and centered under the epaulet.

	Chevrons		All chevrons are placed on the sleeve 1/2 inch below the world patch and centered under the epaulet. The highest class should be closest to the world patch and should be ordered in ascending order (Lowest class earned on the bottom). On short sleeve shirts, each chevron may be sewn on the minimal spacing between them.	


Honor Sash

Black with a maximum width of "3 wide" and length not to extend beyond the fingertips of the left hand and worn "over" the epaulets. Note: "3 wide" is the name Advent Source uses for the extra wide sash that holds 3 side by side honor patches across the width of the sash.

Class Insignia	Although classwork insignia is required to be on the shirt, if a duplicate set is desired, it may be worn on the sash. If worn on the sash, place insignia in the area above the right pocket toward the shoulder in ascending order (lowest class on the bottom).
Name tag	Not recommended for Pathfinder due to security considerations.
Patches	Camporee and Honor patches should be arranged in a neat and orderly fashion. All patches must be sewn on, not glued, stapled, and/or pinned.
Allowances	Items placed on the sash should be Pathfinder related. Items earned in a Pathfinder sponsored event or in the completion of Classwork including such items as the Presidential Fitness Award are acceptable.
Not Allowed	Military insignia and/or non-Pathfinder insignia

Berets (Optional)

Black - The slope of the beret slants to the right and should be on an angle such that a continuation of the arm and hand would be in line with the slant while rendering a proper salute. The beret is worn so that the headband (edge binding) is straight across the forehead and level, 1 inch above the eyebrows. The emblem known as the "flash" is positioned level over the left eye and the excess beret material is draped over to the right ear, extending to at least the top of the ear, and no lower than the middle of the ear. Pathfinders should cut off the ends of the adjusting ribbon once proper size is obtained and secured with a knot and tuck the ribbon knot inside the edge binding at the back of the beret. Note: Special teams may have discretion as to the color of the beret.



- Ties are not part of the Pathfinder Uniform
- **Jewelry** Jewelry is not part of the Pathfinder uniform and should not be worn with the uniform with exception to Medic Alert Bracelets
- **<u>Class B</u>** Conference blue shirt, jeans, and tennis shoes or sneakers
- **<u>Class C</u>** Club shirt or other shirt as specified by the Club, jeans, tennis shoes or sneakers
- **TLT** Refer to the TLT Manual for uniform specifications
