Pathfinder Excellence & Service Award

This award is a formal recognition of all Potomac Pathfinders who expend an extra effort to be a *Servant of God and a Friend to Man* and rise above and beyond what is usually expected of a Pathfinder. **ANY** Pathfinder willing to put forth the effort **CAN ACHIEVE** this award.

Objectives:

Through completing the Pathfinder Excellence and Service Award (PESA), the Pathfinder will:

- Expand their awareness of needs that they are able to meet.
- Develop project management experience.
- Make an impact on their community through meaningful, thoughtful service.
- Arrive at a deeper understanding of what Christian service is.

Criteria:

Pathfinder Excellence & Service Award is available to any Potomac Conference Pathfinder who completes ALL of the following:

- Completes both basic and advanced Investiture Achievement (IA),
 NOTE: Advanced AI must be completed during the current Pathfinder year. It may be completed for the current level being worked on or for the level last completed.
- Is present at a minimum of 90% of club functions and meetings, NOTE: Absences Excused by Club Director DO NOT count against the 90%
- Attends both Potomac Conference Fair and Camporee,
 NOTE: May ONLY be excused by the Conference Pathfinder Director
- Develops and implements a meaningful Service Project which benefits any group or organization that needs assistance.

Forms & Deadlines:

- Application & Project Proposal due: on or before October 15
- Director's Recommendation due: on or before July 15
- Project Completion Report due: on or before July 15



Service Project:

Time Requirement & Adult Involvement Allowed (varies by grade level or it's equivalent)

- <u>5th or 6th Grade or it's equivalent</u> With a parent or Pathfinder counselor, plan and implement a 20-hour service project. (at least 16 hours must be used in completing the project)
- <u>7th or 8th Grade or it's equivalent</u> With guidance from a parent or Pathfinder counselor, plan and implement a 25-hour service project. (at least 20 hours must be used in completing the project)
- 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th Grade or it's equivalent Plan, develop, and give leadership to others in a 30-hour service project. (at least 24 hours must be used in completing the project)

Project Requirements:

- Planned outside of the regular Community Service Projects offered or planned within the Pathfinder club, church, or conference organization
- Must be pre-approved by the Conference Pathfinder Director.
- Must be completed to the satisfaction of the receiving group/organization even if that is beyond the originally planned time commitment.
- Funding is the responsibility of the individual Pathfinder.
- This is an individual Pathfinder project; however, the Pathfinder may enlist other Pathfinder or volunteer help when executing the PESA project.
