## <u>Please Note</u>

- All food items sold must be 100% Vegetarian both in preparation and product.
- Clubs will receive a confirmation permit which must be displayed at their food booth.
- Clubs not listed above will not be permitted to sell food items.
- Please maintain the same price point for items sold through out the entire day to avoid price wars.
- All clubs are asked to use good food service techniques by wearing food service gloves and hair nets as well as practicing good hand washing and sanitation techniques.
- All clubs are responsible for picking up litter, providing <u>trash cans and bags</u> and picking up trash around their food booth area and leaving the location around their food booth clean, and neat.
- Any clubs not having the proper safety equipment and proper disposal container will be instructed to shut down food service immediately.
- Clubs selling food must check in and out with the Food Booth Coordinator. Clubs not checking out may loose points for the Fair.
