





### Planning for Camporee



- · If you are not 95% done, you are probably behind ©
- · Overcommunicate with your staff to make sure they know what to expect
- · Double check with all providers: travel, food, supplies to ensure you have no last minute issues
- · Come up with a plan for how you are going to deal with crises
  - · Issues will come up; if you have a plan ahead of time it is better
  - · It is advisable for every pathfinder to have a health card with them for this event
  - · I cannot stress enough, get ARM Insurance on every member of your club
  - · Make sure you know where Mom and Dad are going to be !!!!
    - · Story time with Jeff on Parents taking vacation out of the country during an event

#### Conference Game Plan



Three Big Challenges with Gillette (Travel, Wind, and Food)

- Travel
  - You have to figure out how to get cross country, but how is your gear going to get there
    - The Conference is negotiating to rent two tractor trailers 34 pallets each
      - Pallet size is 48" x 40" and can be stacked 72" high
      - Pallet cost will be under \$500 (still trying to negotiate down)

#### Wind

- The normal grey or white tarp systems most clubs use for camping kitchen tents will likely last on order of minutes in the consistent 30 mph winds of Gillette
  - The Conference is in negotiations to rent a number of "party tents" to be set up between clubs so that they can be shared kitchen tents for clubs details to follow shortly

#### Food

- The camporee organizers have convinced themselves that everything in Oshkosh was bought at Walmart, hence the Walmart in Gillette is planning to replicate the Oshkosh Inventory
  - · The Conference is negotiating with SYSCO to have tractor trailers of food brought in
  - IF AND ONLY IF we can organize what the clubs need and organize clubs paying in advance



### Travel - Getting Gear to Gillette



We have a contract for two trucks - each can realistically hold 27 or 28 pallets (turns out - you can't get 34 40"x48" pallets in a truck)

We put out a registration form in February and all the available spots are taken

It will cost \$500 per pallet; we are actually taking a loss at that price but with all the other expenses for clubs we held firm at the quoted price



### Travel - Getting Gear to Gillette



Your pallet will come with one box that is approximately 40"x48"x36" high

- We are borrowing these boxes and so they need to be kept out of the elements
- · We will need these back as soon as you empty them
- We will return them to you on Sabbath or Sunday when you begin to pack up in Gillette.
- You can pack loose gear in that box you can pack equipment in bins on top of that box to have a wrapped pallet 40 x 48 x 84 inches
- We will supply the shrink wrap; you will supply the personnel to wrap your pallet.



### Travel - Packing Day



- We will support a packing day at the General Conference Warehouse on July 21 where you will bring your gear, pack your pallets, and shrink-wrap them.
  - Remember you have to stay within a 40 x 48 footprint all the way up before/after you wrap
- We will load your pallets in the trucks
- We will unload your pallets in Gillette so that they are available on Monday August 5<sup>th</sup>
- You will need to repack your gear before you leave; including having everything completely shrink-wrapped
- If you leave a bunch of lose gear in Gillette, it will be staying in Gillette; we load pallets not gear
- If you do not pick up your gear at the GC on time, it will be discarded; there is no storage option at the warehouse



#### Wind



Sherilyn has a contract for 4 40' x 80' Party Tents to be erected in Potomac Spaces

Each Club that wishes to utilize this space will be offered a minimum of a 20' x 10' area for a kitchen space

We intend to have a small generator to power lights for each tent to facilitate use at night - *DO NOT PLUG YOUR CORDS INTO MY GENERATORS*;

#### I WILL UNPLUG YOU - WITHOUT ASKING - BYOG

You cannot consume food in this space - It violates the inspection policy of the State of Wyoming

You must have a fire blanket to put out any unintended fires so that you do not contaminate everyone else's food with fire extinguisher foam/powder/liquid



### Wind (Continued)



We need everyone to fill out the survey so that we can finalize who is going to take use of these tents.

I am trying to get the larger clubs a little more space if I can (We have 16 - 18 clubs with over 50 attendees)

You can use this space on the outside perimeter as a serving line - You cannot use it as seating area as previously mentioned

I highly recommend having some area under cover for your eating area. I noticed that many clubs are going to have trailers on their areas; these make great wind blocks for a large tent

- There will be two food deliveries during Gillette
- The First on Monday the 5<sup>th</sup>

- A team will help you get your food on those days

### Notes from a Wyomingite



Get good stakes for tents. The longer the better, especially in sandy soil. Metal is usually stronger than plastic, but plastic can be made in more effective shapes than metal. Make sure everything is tied down and that trash cans are covered (things blow away quickly). Make sure skin is covered. You can get wind burn fairly quickly and not realize it.

Watch out for heat-related illnesses and injuries. They can be sneaky. Cover up skin or wear sun screen or sun block. Stay hydrated. Make sure you have plenty of water and some sort of electrolyte. It's semi-arid here, so when you sweat, it tends to evaporate quickly. Feels great, but you need to replenish that liquid and salt or your body can't cool itself.

Watch out for critters. With all the people around, they'll likely be hiding, but they're attracted to water and food, so be careful about leaving stuff out just in case. I usually wear boots whenever I go out to provide an extra layer of protection against critters and falling. Don't leave shoes out at night, they make a great home for crawling critters.

I assume most of your folks will have cell phones, but you can also consider FRS radios. They're relatively inexpensive, no individual license is required, and they're relatively simple to use. Wyoming advertises a specific channel and privacy code for SAR (307). You likely won't need it because you'll be around so many other people and cell should work, but it doesn't hurt to have a backup.


You might consider getting the Wyoming Ready app. It should have more information. I haven't used it, so I can't guarantee it's quality.



#### Additional Information



- As you can see CAM-PLEX is in Gillette, Wyoming
  - . It is neither in the country nor isolated
  - It is in the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest Population Center in Wyoming



- · You MUST BE VIGILANT in watching your Pathfinders
  - · Whenever they leave your camp, they must be with an adult
    - Even when going to the port-a-johns or to the shower houses
  - · We are used to CBR, SVA & Oshkosh, all far more isolated
    - Gillette requires a whole different level of vigilance
    - Think of Gillette as if you were taking your Pathfinders to NYC



### Wyoming is in the West



- . Not a point of Alarm, just a point of information
  - 66.2% of households in Wyoming have guns
  - · It is not uncommon for citizens of Wyoming to openly carry pistols
  - Educate your Pathfinders on this fact
    - It is a different Culture
    - One that requires respect
    - · And like everywhere else in the world, Pathfinders should be RESPECTFUL
- Point of Fact, it might surprise you to find out the % of Pathfinder leaders that own Guns



### What to do when you arrive



- 1. BEFORE YOU LEAVE
  - PRINT ALL YOUR DOCUMENTS and BRING THE COPY WITH YOU. Don't rely on WIFI or cell service.
- 2. Do NOT arrive before Monday Morning; if you do, you will be sitting in your transportation until Monday
  - We will not have space marked out before Monday
  - You will not be able to get your tickets verified before Monday
- 3. On Monday, If you can enter the property, come to the Potomac Conference Headquarters (HQ)
  - We will have a 12' x 2' sign at our entrance so you should be able to find HQ
  - We will tell you where your camp site is going to be
  - You will have 80 square feet per person (hopefully more, won't know until I walk the space)
- 4. Send one or two representatives over to the Camporee Registration Area in the Wyoming Center
  - Bring ALL the printed tickets for your club with you; this is why your printed them in step 1 before you left
  - Your club account will be pulled up to verify that your printouts match.
  - You will then be issued wristbands for every ticket. FYI: Jr Tickets will have a different color than general admission tickets.
  - NOTE: If you bought or sold tickets from another club after the July 3 deadline OR if you never contacted CYE to get those tickets transferred into the secondary purchasing club's account, the club with the original purchase will be given the wristband for those tickets. The original purchasing club will need to turn the wristbands over to the secondary purchasing club. IF you have any challenges, come to conference HQ and we can help sort things out.

## TLT Information Application Process



- First time TLTs MUST complete both the recommendation forms and the application form; returning TLTs only complete the application form
- These are first approved by club then by conference
- Mentors: anyone with strong leadership skills within the church; doesn't have to be a club member but preferred
- Each semester a TLT must complete a minimum of 72 hours of service (SS, club meetings, audio/visual, church leadership, outreach, etc.)

- These rules will also be for the International Camporee. *Potomac will be competing Wednesday Afternoon at Gillette* 

**Registration:** Via the Potomac Pathfinder Website only. Please don't register multiple times if changes are needed please call or e-mail.

**Fee Structure:** There will be a \$30 registration fee for each team competing.

- \$120 for participation in all 4 categories (Basic, Advanced, Fancy and Drum)
- \$90 for any combination of 3 teams
- \$60 for any combination of 2 teams

**Bonus Points:** A <u>maximum of 15 points</u> will be awarded for participating in this event. Participation in any category ie, Basic, Advanced, Freestyle, or Drum Corps

**Drill Instructors/Drum Corps Captains:** May be a Pathfinder, TLT (18 or under), or Staff of any Age. The Instructor/Captain will be the only one allowed to direct the team/corps on the floor during the exhibition and cannot be coached from the sideline.

**Team Size:** A minimum of 4 Pathfinders (If your Drill Instructor is a Pathfinder and/or a TLT they may be one of the 4, this is not encouraged but permitted)


